Excellence Award For Trainer of the Year (2007 – 2008)

National CFC Consumption Phase out Plan (NCCoPP) has instituted the ***Excellence Award for the trainer of the year.*** This award is initiated by INFRAS being the implementing agency for NCCoPP primarily responsible for the training component. About 16,000 technicians from the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Enterprises have been trained under NCCoPP and its predecessor project. This achievement was possible with the team work of the training cells, RMO, others directly or indirectly associated with the project and in particular the trainers imparting the training. The trainers are the direct interface with the technicians or the participants of the training programs. Hence to recognize and encourage the trainer for his contributions to impart theory and practical training to the Refrigeration Sector Enterprise technicians on Good Servicing Practices in refrigeration sector and the technology for using alternative refrigerants, to create a competitive environment among the trainers and motivate them to enhance their training skills and quality the “excellence award for trainer of the year” is announced.

Nomination for the award is on voluntary basis for all the trainers under NCCoPP. However, **each Training Cell and Whirlpool India Ltd. can nominate only one** of their trainers and **Godrej & Boyce Mfg Co. Ltd. being the main industry training partner can send a maximum of 3 nominations.** Contesting training cells and industries should send their nominations by 15th February 2007 for the year 2007-08, to Regional Management Organization Quest (RMO) by post or

email (questvs@gmail.com). The nominations would be scrutinized by the members of the jury appointed by INFRAS. The decision of the jury a) would be based on the information filled in by the trainer in the nomination form and monitoring reports and b) can not be challenged.

Who can apply

- Trainers associated with the NCCoPP training programs both from Training Cells and Industry.
- Attended Training of Trainers Program under HIDECOR or NCCoPP.
- Conducted at least two training programs per year for minimum of two years and involved in theory as well as practical classes.
- At least one of the training programs conducted by the trainer under NCCoPP has been externally monitored.
- Trainers cum organizers are not eligible.

How to nominate

- Nomination has to be made by an organiser or an industry partner (and not by an individual trainer).

What award is granted

The following awards will be granted:

- 1 excellence award (selected out of all applicants).
- 3 outstanding awards to applicants from Training Cells and Whirlpool India Ltd.
- 1 outstanding award to applicants from Godrej & Boyce Mfg Co. Ltd.

The selected trainers will be awarded a certificate & cash /cheque worth INR 10'000.- for the excellence award and a certificate & cash/ cheque worth INR 5'000.- for outstanding award. In addition, the names, photos and addresses of the selected trainers along with a short summary of their contributions will be published on the NCCoPP web site and in theEcoCoolmagazine.
